## Description of activity

The BTEC WorkSkills Qualification comprises of a suite of over 30 stand-alone bite sized units. WorkSkills units fall into four main pathways:

- Personal life skills;
- Sustainable employment skills;
- Work placement skills; and
- Skills for business.

REBP will work with the school to develop and deliver an activity which will support a specific unit of the qualification. Activities that have been delivered in the past include mock interviews at a business premises and enterprise days. Sessions can be delivered over a course of lessons or through one day activities.

### Through this activity students will:

- take part in an activity that contributes to their qualification; and
- collect evidence which supports specific aspects of their qualification.
