Description of activity

REBP will work with an employer to arrange an opportunity for students to visit a business premises and investigate a specific industry or career route.

It will allow students to understand how the curriculum relates to the world of work as well as helping them make informed future career choices.

This activity is flexible and will be tailored to suit schools, students, and employer requirements. An individual programme will be devised for each insight day.

Insight visits have previously included – a construction site, a hairdressers and a retail outlet.

Through this activity students will:

- experience working with an employer.
