

Work experience debriefing session

Description of activity

A work experience debriefing session enables students to reflect on their placements, identify links to the curriculum and have an opportunity to compare and contrast different working practices and employment sectors.

Schools deliver debriefing sessions in a variety of ways therefore the EBP is flexible with the support that can be provided for this activity.

For example:

- Engaging employers to support pre-planned sessions led by tutors
- Leading a session within assembly
- Assisting work experience co-ordinators to develop a programme of activities that can be delivered as part of a work experience debriefing session.

Through this activity students will:

- be given an opportunity to reflect on their work experience placements

Other learning outcomes will depend on the activity.
